Last summer a new park was being build in Llantwit major, for the children and young people of the community. It was important to get young peoples views, and as



volunteers a group of us were involved in the planning. So members of the council came to see us at the youth centre, and laid out plans of the park. We were given sheets with numbers to give our views on, and select different play equipment that we thought was needed. We had to tick a maximum of 5 items.

During the summer, the building began! and a few weeks later it was complete. Containing a climbing frame, a big swing, a zip wire and much more equipment.

We hope there are plenty of sunny days coming up for people to enjoy the new park that the volunteers helped to design!
